ABOUT THE THEME OF WEBINAR

The National Education Policy 2020, ("NEP") is only a few days old and has been garnering a lot of attention. The NEP approved by the Union Cabinet at a meeting presided by Prime Minister Narendra Modi replaces the 34-year-old National Policy on Education framed in 1986 and is aimed at paving the way for transformational reforms in school and higher education systems to make India a global knowledge superpower.

The NEP 2020, is a practical blueprint for the holistic development of the youth of the 21st century. It has envisaged a vision for seeking substantive change with a view to harnessing the extraordinary potential of human development and India's demographic dividend. NEP 2020 has break-down the existing 10+2 structure and introduction of the new 5+3+3+4 structure of education. It has envisaged the creation of a liberal, multidisciplinary and inter-disciplinary education ecosystem with strong emphasis on the liberal arts, humanities and social sciences along with studies in STEM and Medicine. "No hard separation of arts and sciences." The new education policy aims to give students increased flexibility and choice of subjects to study across the arts, humanities, sciences, sports, and vocational subjects.

As per the policy, the medium of instruction until at least class 5, but preferably till class 8 and beyond, will be the home language, mother tongue, local language and regional language. No language is being imposed in the new National Education Policy and a flexible approach has been proposed with the three-language formula, according to the policy drafting panel chief K Kasturirangan. "Children have a great ability to pick up multiple languages in early age. How it will be implemented in states it is their decision.", he said.

Education for a new generation of learners has to necessarily engage with the increasing dematerialization and digitalization of our economies, requiring a completely new set of capabilities in order to be able to keep up. In this regard, the Policy notes that one of the central principles steering the education system will be the 'extensive use of technology in teaching and learning.' It is also proposed that coding be introduced in school curriculums as an important skill that students must develop. The National Education Policy, 2020 is revolutionary in every sense. While the Policy focuses on multiple aspects, including the need for early childhood care, inclusive education and revamping of the current curriculum, an inherent thread that runs through the Policy is the interplay of education and technology.
